Reclamation and Revegetation

Since 2010 we have planted over 178,000 mostly indigenous tree seedlings in our work to rehabilitate over 1,100 hectares of land. Since 2010 we have spent almost US\$ 62 million on reclamation.

As at the end of 2018, our Ghanaian tenements covered over 1,400 km² of land, of which less than 2% has been developed for our operations.

As at the end of 2018 our operations had applied to the EPA for release of over 40 reclaimed areas of land covering over 100 hectares in total. been deemed These have achieving Final Completion - in effect, they have been returned community use. Included in these areas of land are re-forested areas, plantations of economic trees, oil palm plantation, water resources, and areas of land now used by the community for farming and housing

estates.
